The City of Cherokee City Council held a Committee Work Session on Wednesday, August 20, 2014 at 6 p.m. in Sac City, Iowa to meet with Jeff Schott, Director of the University of Iowa, Institute of Public Affairs regarding loss of Tyson Deli, a major manufacturer in Cherokee, Iowa. Present at the meeting were Mark Murphy, Mayor, Council members Emily Johnson, Will Miller and Chad Brown and Administrator Don Eikmeier. Subjects covered during the meeting included the impact on the City's General Fund and Utility Funds, the direct loss of revenue in the Water and Wastewater Funds, the control of the lease of the industrial plant by Tyson Deli, alternative means of restructuring City staffing to offset the loss of Tyson Water and Wastewater revenues, and possible assistance of the Institute of Public Affairs to the City in developing and implementing a long term strategy to offset the loss of Tyson. No action was taken at the Work Session. Meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:10 p.m.
