N. Roosevelt Improvement Project from South of Jefferies Street to North of E. Indian Street

Construction is to start on

**This project will include
replacement of Water Main and
Street.**

Within the two weeks you will see construction crews and equipment preparing to begin work to improve your water main and roads in your neighborhood.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

Crews will be removing pavement and digging to replace water mains and services. This work will replace an aging water main and provide a new concrete driving surface for your street.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Residents will see construction workers and equipment in your neighborhood. Road closure should be anticipated in order to complete work.

HOW TO PREPARE:

When work begins avoid parking your vehicles on the street. Construction crews will be closing the site to all traffic at some point of construction and you may be required to use side streets for parking. There will be some interruptions in water service as required in the installation of the new water main. No user should be without water for more than 3 hours during a shut down. Mail boxes will be relocated in the street right-of-way outside of the construction zone. There should be no change in mail deliveries. Please continue to follow your current practice with garbage and recycling as the contractor will be working with Sanitation Services to insure continued service throughout the project construction.
