**Applicant has read and agrees to the following regulations:**

1. **TRAFFIC CONTROL.** The flow of traffic in streets and access to private property shall be reasonably maintained at all times. The applicant shall provide a safe roadway and shall erect and maintain warning signs, barricades and sufficient safeguards around all excavations, embankments and obstructions in accordance to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The applicant shall provide suitable warning lights or flares and shall keep them lighted from one-half hour before sunset until one-half hour after sunrise and all other times when visibility is limited. The applicant shall further provide such flagmen and watchmen as required by city officials or inspector for the protection of the public. The design, placement and maintenance of traffic control devices shall correlate with and so far as possible conform to the system set forth in the most recent edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways. The roadway shall be properly maintained and the applicant shall coordinate his operations with the city representative in order that suitable arrangements may be made for detours, parking and access to private property, etc. Whenever a street is closed or partially closed, the City of Cherokee shall be notified of the closing. When normal service is resumed, the City of Cherokee shall be notified. In the event it is determined that the applicant is not maintaining a safe roadway, the City of Cherokee may improve the roadway conditions at the applicant's expense.
2. **DAMAGES.** The applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Cherokee, its officers and employees, for any loss or cost, liability, damage, claim, demand or cause of action arising from, under or connected with the excavations and work covered by this application.
3. **CLEAN UP.** The applicant shall frequently clean up all refuse, rubbish, scrap materials and debris as a result of his operations so that at all times the site of work shall present a neat and orderly appearance. Upon completion of the work, the applicant shall remove from the site and any occupied adjoining property, all plants, buildings, rubbish, unused

materials, form lumber and other materials belonging to him, his contractor or subcontractor. Any costs incurred by the city due to failure by the applicant to clean up to the city's satisfaction will be charged to the account of the applicant or his surety.

4. The applicant, or his contractor, certifies they have liability insurance for the work covered by this permit.
5. The applicant must call City Hall at 712-225-5749 for inspection 2 hours prior to pouring any concrete.
6. This application is accompanied by a \$25.00 fee.
